The Opportunity

Reporting to the Director of Programs and Global Initiatives, and working alongside the Program Manager, the Senior Manager of Programs, will manage key organizational programs, ensuring alignment with North Forge's global strategy and objectives. In this critical role, the Senior Manager of Programs will actively engage with ambitious founders, providing them with vital support, including intake assessments, pitch training, and mentorship. The successful incumbent will play a key role in expanding existing programming and relaunching the North Forge Angel Network.

Key Responsibilities

- → Recruit ambitious founders, conduct intake meetings, and provide pitch training as needed.
- → Design and implement the curriculum to assist entrepreneurs to expand their market reach, improve operational efficiency, launch new products or services and enhance customer experiences.
- → Contribute to the design and implementation of new programming initiatives, while expanding existing programs.
- → Collaborate with the Director of Programs and Global Initiatives to define clear program goals, set objectives, and develop long-term strategies for expansion, innovation, and improvement.
- → Oversee and expand key initiatives like the North Forge Angel Network, the Advanced Manufacturing Lab (AMLab), and the high school program.
- → Gather and evaluate data to assess program performance, uncover trends, and identify opportunities for increasing participation and engagement.
- → Monitor key metrics and deliver regular insightful reports to leadership and stakeholders.
